By May 1st all parish households in St. Leo's and St. Thomas parishes will have been invited and have had the opportunity to attend a Campaign reception for the Diocese of Fargo's \$20 million Capital Campaign. *I pray you all will be able to attend*.

On March 27th all parish households were mailed a letter about this very important campaign. It has been over 30 years since the Diocese of Fargo last conducted a major campaign to raise funds for major needs in our life as a diocesan church. This \$20 million campaign is aimed at raising money to support —

- > the renovation and endowment of our Maryvale Retreat Center
- > construct and sustain a priests' retirement home
- > support and grow the diocesan priest retirement fund as well as
- > direct and infuse 30% of all raised money back to local parish projects of their choosing.

As parishes within the Diocese of Fargo we, like all the 125 parishes and missions, are being asked to support this Capital Campaign. Over a period of four years St. Leo's parish is being asked to raise \$289,000 and St. Thomas is being asked to raise \$49,500.

The upcoming Campaign receptions are meant to give fuller details on these projects and answer any questions you may have. Each parish household will receive an invitation through the mail to attend a reception. Once you receive your invitation please <u>mark your calendar</u> and **RSVP to St. Leo's parish office** (347-4609).

Just by way of information — this past Fall 30 of our diocesan parishes/missions have already completed their campaign receptions and their pledges have surpassed their collective goal of \$3,951,951. St. Leo's and St. Thomas are now in the second cohort of 34 diocesan parishes/missions to conduct their campaign receptions. The remaining 61 parishes/missions will conduct their outreach this coming Fall. With all of us pulling together and doing our part this campaign will be a success.

Our weekly bulletin will contain ongoing communications and notifications about this project. *Looking* forward to seeing you at one of the upcoming receptions.
