The awesome work of Catholic Charities began in 1923 under the leadership of Msgr. Vincent Ryan and was called the *Catholic Welfare Bureau*. In the 1950s St. Leo's pastor – Msgr. Anthony Peschel – oversaw the operations of Catholic Charities and made the move to hire professionally educated Social Workers. During this time the Catholic Charities was renamed *Catholic Family Services*. Today the organization is known as <u>Catholic Charities North Dakota</u>.

To this day Catholic Charities is still most known for helping place children for adoption, which was there from the very beginning. Over the years they have added counseling *[individual, family, marriage]*, guardianship programs for the intellectually disabled and vulnerable adults.

Over the years countless thousands of families have been served by the ministry of *Catholic Charities North Dakota*. Come help us celebrate 100 years of doing God's work of

charity and love throughout the state of North Dakota.
