This weekend, the Fargo Diocese is observing *Safe Haven Sunday* in an effort to educate people on the harm that pornography does to individuals, marriages, families, and society as a whole.



CONNECTED is the 3rd in a series of booklets presented by Covenant Eyes. It is a proactive resource that explores how a strong family connection can protect children and teens from the dangers of hidden pornography use. It contains real-life stories and practical tips for maintaining or re-establishing connection in your family. CONNECTED will strengthen your relationship with God, your spouse and your children, so that your family can live free of pornography.

- The prevalence of loneliness in today's society and how it fuels porn use
