VBS (Vacation Bible School) — another successful year!!

On Thursday we finished our 4-day 2020 VBS with the celebration of Mass followed by some ice cream treats. This year's VBS was limited to 20 students in order to maintain safety concerns connected with COVID-19.

Each day was divided into 4 parts: (1) Bible stories; (2) craft time; (3) outdoor activities; and (4) church time. The children made lots of crafts and learned about a number of things: how God saved Peter and Paul in times of trouble; how to bless oneself and genuflect to the tabernacle when coming into church; how our stained glass windows are 'old time movies' about the church from the story of creation until life in heaven; were given wheat seed to be planted in good soil (not on the pavement at the reservoir, nor on the stony ground, nor in the weeds); told about the staircase to heaven; visited St. Leo's cemetery and prayed at specific graves and for all the deceased. All in all it was a good year!

All of this happened because of a great group of volunteers for this year's High Seas Expedition: Bryce Radermacher (Captain Jack) and Station Leaders: Karren Bartholomay for Bible stories, Sherry Radermacher and Lilly Roth for craft projects, and Olivea Roth, Andy Garman and Anthony Garman for outdoors sports. In addition to the station leaders there were our Group leaders: Addison Hushka; Olivia Garman and Evelyn Roth.

Flooring in the sanctuary (the altar area)

We would ask that you share any comments with any of the Pastoral Council members by Thursday, August 6th (the Feast of the Transfiguration).
