# May 1<sup>st</sup> - St. Joseph the Worker

Throughout the world many nations celebrate May 1<sup>st</sup> as their 'Labor Day' or as it is often called – *International Workers Day*. In 1955 Pope Pius XII dedicated May 1<sup>st</sup> as "St. Joseph the Worker, husband of the Blessed Virgin Mary, confessor and patron of Working People". His intention was to give a Christian dimension to the whole notion of work and the gift of human labor.

In this year of St. Joseph it seems appropriate to examine this Christian dimension of work and how that perspective should shape the gift of human labor. In its deepest dimension work is done to improve the quality of one's life. First and foremost that means meeting the most basic human needs we all have for food, shelter and clothing. Beyond this most rudimentary understanding of work, work should engage the human spirit so as to bestow self-worth and dignity upon the worker. Each worker should find pride in their labor. By the work of one's hand one offers products to others that improve and better the welfare of the human race whether that be the most menial of labor to the highest realms of professional living. All labor is meant to improve the conditions of human living all in keeping with God's design for the human race. In essence all human labor is meant to sanctify the human race.

This work of sanctification should guide and direct all work. Work should bring glory to God, be morally righteous, structured in justice, serve the poor and call forth our 'better angels' so as to give back to God a saintly life by which the human race is better off because I have lived and worked.

Such is the mystery of that carpenter's shop in Nazareth!!
