Upcoming Events

- > Sunday, May 31st we will honor our graduating seniors at the 10:30 a.m. Mass all the while respecting the safety guidelines in place at that time;
- > Wednesday, June 3rd The annual <u>Chrism Mass</u> with Bishop Folda will be celebrated at St. Mary's Cathedral at 11 a.m. *Given the safety measures of this time only the priests of the Diocese of Fargo will be in attendance*. At this Mass the 3 sacred oils of the Church (<u>Oil of the Catechumens</u>; <u>Oil of the Sick and Sacred Chrism</u>) will be blessed and brought back to our parishes to be used in the course of this coming year. Also, the priests of the Diocese will renew their priestly vows.
- > Friday, June 11th Bishop John Folda will be here to celebrate the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist at 6:30 p.m. for the 24 students from our parishes of St. Leo's and St. Thomas. There are a number of tasks yet to be completed (e.g. one last class for parents, student interviews, a modified retreat, a short rehearsal and some sacramental preparation books still need to be completed and turned in everyone's cooperation in these matters is deeply appreciated).

<u>Note</u>: Next week's bulletin will contain all the specific information and details for those students who will be celebrating the <u>sacrament of Reconciliation</u> (tentatively scheduled for the week following Confirmation).

Some Facility notes (St. Leo's parish)

- > church painting the nave of the church (area of the pews) is **done**; hopefully on Tuesday of this week, the altar area is scheduled to be painted followed by the choir loft and small remaining areas.
- > stripping and waxing of the nave's floor **DONE!**
- > church's chimney is no longer necessary for heating purposes and was in need of much repair as well as believed to be the source of water damage at the ceiling level by the Mary statue. It was decided to be taken down and capped at the roof line with eventually assessing whether the church's roof line can be extended and made to cover the remaining chimney entirely.
- > church's elevator contract has been signed; various component parts have been ordered; usually takes a minimum of ten (10) weeks once a contract is signed before we will have an operational elevator. No further reports as of this time.
