> For this week —

- A) At the beginning of this week each parish household in St. Leo's parish will be mailed their annual Fall Raffle tickets. As in the last number of years each parish household is being asked to either sell or buy a packet of 6 tickets with each ticket costing \$20. The money raised from the ticket sales goes toward the many facility projects that have been done over the last number of years. From 2008 to date we have spent nearly \$500,000 in improvement projects (e.g. front steps and new entry doors in 2011; new church lighting in 2013; update of Spirit of Life Center kitchen in 2017; new church parking lot in 2019; church painting and elevator replacement in 2020, etc.). Your support of our Fall Raffle has enabled us to do these many worthwhile projects. Your continual support of this year's raffle is deeply appreciated.
- B) <u>Please note</u> A number of local parishes are doing modified take-out food orders in place of their normal Fall Dinners. We would like to see if that could work for St. Leo's.
