Over the years your generous support of these ticket sales has enabled us to do many facility improvement projects that were listed in the letter that accompanied the mailing. Your continual support is deeply appreciated!

Also included in that mailing was a take-out order for <u>just</u> roast beef and gravy on Sunday, November 1st when we normally would have had our full Fall Dinner. Given these pandemic days many local parishes are doing modified versions of their Fall Dinners. Since St. Leo's is noted for their roast beef and gravy we thought *selling <u>JUST</u> roast beef & gravy* was something that could be safely done on a take-out basis. Your mailing included a take-out order form as well as instructions.

<u>Please note</u>: all take-out orders **must be pre-paid** and in the parish office by **Sunday, October 25**th. On Monday, October 26th we will put in our order for the roast beef. Again your support of this fund-raising effort is deeply appreciated!

Who assists/helps — mentally disabled & vulnerable adults? ... children in foster care? ... those unable to conceive or those with unplanned pregnancies? ... individuals, marriages or families in need of faith-based counseling? The answer to all of these questions is Catholic Charities North Dakota!

Catholic Charities North Dakota (CCND) is the Catholic Church's pastoral arm of mercy reaching out across the state of North Dakota.

As you well know there are many wonderful organizations doing charitable work in helping people in their times of need. In many ways the work of CCND is not as well known as more publicized groups like shelters and food pantries. CCND's work is connected to long term projects that entails relationship skills. Presently the work of CCND is grouped under 4 headings:

- 1) Guardianship services to over 500 vulnerable adults with intellectual disabilities. A courtappointed guardian is assigned to each of these persons who need support with decision-making to prevent abuse, neglect and exploitation. CCND services includes visits and attending meetings and appointments to insure each guardian's well-being. In addition CCND operates a 24 hour emergency/assistance line. In the state of North Dakota there is a long waiting list beyond the present ones being helped.
- 2) Adults Adopting Special Kids {AASK} works with finding 'forever' homes for children in foster care. Most recently over 800 kids received AASK services. As with the Guardianship program there are many on waiting lists to receive care.
- 3) Pregnancy, Parenting and Adoption Services (PPAS) help people who are unprepared for pregnancy to learn about options for parenting and adoption. In addition to those unprepared for pregnancy, there are couples who desire the gift of a child and seek the services of an adoption agency. CCND adoption services also help with adoption searches and disclosures.
- **4)** Counseling services are provided for individuals, couples and families who are coping with crisis, stress and change in their lives.

As a person can see the work of Catholic Charities North Dakota touches a lot of homes who are need of help and the tender mercy of God. CCND works at healing and reconciling the 'woundedness' of the human condition and deserve our deepest appreciation and support.
